2. Must be a full or part-time faculty (feel free to collaborate and share the award)
3. Must participate in a brainstorming session with the Deans, Director of Teaching and Learning Center, Representative of the Professional Development Committee and the Learning Technologist, Courtney Griffin twice prior to the submission day to discuss innovation, curricular goals, effective use of technology, processes or pedagogical impact (follow-up meeting with individuals if necessary)
4. Must present your submission to the Faculty Development Committee
