- _____ All applicants who are enrolled in program courses at other institutions **MUST** provide official transcripts with posted grades by the May 23, 2019 deadline.

- _____ HESI A² exam results must be dated within 2 years of the program start date and must include Reading Comprehension, Mathematics, Anatomy & Physiology, Learning Styles, and Personality Profile. Deadline for HESI A² testing is May 10, 2019.

- _____ Nursing general education courses must be completed with a minimum GPA of 2.5 for admission consideration. Additionally, the Morton College cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0.

- _____ All applicants must attend a Nursing Information Session. Attendance does **NOT** roll over from previous application years.

- _____ Valid and current proof of residency must accompany the application.
Note: Applicants wanting in-district consideration (whether living in-district or working in-district) must submit proof by March 1, 2019. Status **CANNOT** be changed after March 1, 2019. Final in-district status for applicants submitting an In-District Employment Verification form is contingent upon review from the Registrar and verification by the Nursing committee.

- _____ IF ADMITTED INTO THE 2019 FALL NURSING PROGRAM you will be required to attend the Mandatory Nursing Orientation, on Wednesday June 26, 2019* 8am-3pm, and Mandatory Nursing Boot Camp, August 6-8, 2019* 9am-3pm each day. Attendance to the Nursing Orientation and Nursing Boot Camp is **MANDATORY**, **failure to attend will result in the forfeiture of your seat in the nursing program.** **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
Note: Acceptance into the Nursing program does NOT roll over.
