The Morton College Foundation (MCF) is an independent 501 c (3) established in 1976. Its mission is to provide financial support to Morton College, its faculty and staff and Morton College students who seek to reach their fullest potential through quality education.

Over the last 40 years, MCF has awarded over \$800,000 in scholarships and awards to over 1300 students. MCF has also awarded Outstanding Service Awards to about 100 Morton College faculty and classified staff. Furthermore, MCF has provided funds for computers, electronic signage and an upgrade to the JPAC sound system.

In February, 2016 MCF awarded this year's Outstanding Service Awards to two faculty and two classified staff members. MCF also hosted a successful "Dinner and A Show" fundraiser where the attendees enjoyed the JPAC production of ER.

Over the past 2 years, MCF has awarded over \$40,000 each year in scholarships and awards to students. MCF looks forward to doing that again this year at the May 6th Convocation (Awards Ceremony). This year MCF will again give each scholarship awardee a gift of a padfolio and pen.

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Independent Auditor's Report

To the Board of Directors Morton College Foundation

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Morton College Foundation (the "Foundation"), which comprise the statement of financial position as of June 30, 2015 and the related statements of activities and changes in net assets and cash flows for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audits. We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinions.

Opinion

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Morton College Foundation as of June 30, 2015 and the changes in net assets and its cash flows for the years then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Notes to Financial Statements June 30, 2015 and 2014

Note I - Nature of Business and Significant Accounting Policies

Morton College Foundation (the "Foundation") is an Illinois not-for-profit organized to provide support exclusively for the objectives and purposes of Morton College - Community College District No. 527 (the "College") and to augment the facilities of the College in such a manner as may be designated by its board of directors. All distributions made out of the Foundation, other than normal operating expenses, are to be made to or for the benefit of the College. Upon dissolution of the Foundation, its remaining assets will be distributed as scholarships to students.

Basis of Accounting - The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Under these principles, the Foundation is required to report information regarding its financial positions and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Cash Equivalents - The Foundation considers all highly liquid investments purchased with original maturities of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

The carrying amount of cash and cash equivalents shown in the accompanying financial statements include depository with local financial institutions. The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) provides insurance coverage up to \$250,000 deposited at an FDIC-insured bank.

Contributions - Contributions of cash and other assets, including unconditional promises to give in the future, are reported as revenue when received, measured at fair value. Donor promises to give in the future are recorded at the present value of estimated future cash flows.

Contributions without donor-imposed restrictions and contributions with donor-imposed time or purpose restrictions that are met in the same period as the gift are both reported as unrestricted support. Other restricted gifts are reported as restricted support and temporarily or permanently restricted net assets.

Investments - Investments at June 30, 2015 and 2014 consist of certificates of deposit and are carried at cost, based upon the face value of the certificate of deposit plus accrued interest. The Foundation intends to hold its investments to maturity.

Property and Equipment - Property and equipment are recorded at cost when purchased and at estimated fair market value when donated. Depreciation on property and equipment is provided on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of the assets. Depreciation expense for the years ended June 30, 2015 and 2014 amounted to \$0 and \$253, respectively.

Notes to Financial Statements June 30, 2015 and 2014

Note I - Nature of Business and Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Classification of Net Assets - Net assets of the Foundation are classified as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted depending on the presence and characteristics of donor-imposed restrictions limiting the Foundation's ability to use or dispose of contributed assets or the economic benefits embodied in those assets.

Unrestricted Net Assets - Net assets that are not restricted by donors or the donor-imposed restrictions have expired.

Temporarily Restricted Net Assets - Net assets subject to donor-imposed restrictions that permit the Foundation to use or expend the assets as specified. The donor-imposed restrictions are purpose-restricted for the specific programs. Temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities and changes in net assets as net assets released from restrictions when the restrictions are satisfied either by the passage of time or by actions of the Foundation. However, if a restriction is fulfilled in the same time period in which the contribution is received, the Foundation reports the support as unrestricted.

Permanently Restricted Net Assets - Net assets that are subject to donor-imposed restrictions that stipulate the resources be maintained permanently, but permit the Foundation to use or expend part or all of the income derived from the donated assets for specified purposes. Investment earnings available for distribution are recorded in temporarily or unrestricted net assets.

Functional Allocation of Expenses - The costs of providing the program and support services are reported on a functional basis. Costs are allocated between the various programs and support services on an actual basis, where available, or based upon reasonable methods. Although methods of allocation used are considered appropriate, other methods could be used that would produce different amounts.

Use of Estimates - The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue, expenses, and other changes in net assets during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Notes to Financial Statements June 30, 2015 and 2014

Note I - Nature of Business and Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Risks and Uncertainties - The investments of the Foundation are composed of domestic certificates of deposit that are exposed to various risks, such as interest rates, market factors, and other credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment funds, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the value of the certificates of deposit will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the statement of financial position.

Federal Income Taxes - The Foundation is exempt from income tax under provisions of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Foundation and recognize a tax liability if the Foundation has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS or other applicable taxing authorities. Management has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Foundation and has concluded that as of June 30, 2015 and 2014, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability or disclosure in the financial statements. The Foundation is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. Management believes it is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to June 30, 2012.

Subsequent Events - The financial statements and related disclosures include evaluation of events up through and including February 29, 2016, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

Note 4 - Donor Restricted Endowments

The Foundation's endowment consists of donor-restricted endowment funds. Net assets associated with endowment funds are classified and reported based on the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions.

Interpretation of Relevant Law

The board of directors of the Foundation has interpreted the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as requiring the preservation of the fair value of the original gift as of the gift date of the donor-restricted endowment funds absent explicit donor stipulations to the contrary. As a result of this interpretation, the Organization classifies as permanently restricted net assets (a) the original value of gifts donated to the permanent endowment, (b) the original value of subsequent gifts to the permanent endowment, and (c) accumulations to the permanent endowment made in accordance with the direction of the applicable donor gift instrument at the time the accumulation is added to the fund. The remaining portion of the donor-restricted endowment fund that is not classified in permanently restricted net assets is classified as temporarily restricted net assets until those amounts are appropriated for expenditure by the Foundation in a manner consistent with the standard of prudence prescribed by UPMIFA. In accordance with UPMIFA, the Foundation considers the following factors in making a determination to appropriate or accumulate donor-restricted endowment funds:

- (I) The duration and preservation of the fund
- (2) The purposes of the Foundation and the donor-restricted endowment fund
- (3) General economic conditions
- (4) The possible effect of inflation and deflation
- (5) The expected total return from income and the appreciation of investments
- (6) Other resources of the Foundation
- (7) The investment policies of the Foundation

Funds with Deficiencies

From time to time, the fair value of assets associated with individual donor-restricted endowment funds may fall below the level that the donor or UPMIFA requires the Foundation to retain as a fund of perpetual duration. Deficiencies of this nature that are in excess of related temporarily restricted amounts are reported in unrestricted net assets. These deficiencies resulted from unfavorable market fluctuations that occured after investment of permanently restricted contributions. The June 30, 2015 deficiency shown in unrestricted net assets represents scholarship payments made during the year that exceed the earnings on the endowment.

Donor-restricted principal, unless otherwise directed by the donor, shall not be disbursed.

Return Objectives and Risk Parameters

The Foundation has adopted investment and spending policies, approved by the board of directors, for endowment assets that attempt to provide a predictable stream of funding to programs supported by its endowment funds while also maintaining the purchasing power of those endowment assets over the long term. Accordingly, the investment process seeks to achieve an after-cost total real rate of return, including investment income as well as capital appreciation, which exceeds the annual distribution with acceptable levels of risk. Endowment assets are invested in a well diversified asset mix, which mainly includes certificates of deposit that are intended to result in a consistent rate of return that has sufficient liquidity to make an annual distribution for scholarships, while growing the fund if possible. Actual returns in any given year may vary from this amount. Investment risk is measured in terms of the total endowment fund; investment assets and allocation between asset classes and strategies are managed to prevent the fund's exposure to unacceptable levels of risk.

Spending Policy and How the Investment Objectives Relate to Spending Policy

The Foundation has a policy of appropriating current income for distribution for scholarships each year.

Note 5 - Related Party Transactions

Morton College is a public institution, offering a broad array of programs. During the years ended June 30, 2015 and 2014, the Foundation authorized distributions to the College in the amount of \$43,192 and \$41,675, respectively, primarily for scholarships, foundation expenses, and awards.

RATIONALE:

[Required by Board Policy 1.1.1 and Illinois Statute 805/3-45 of the Illinois Public Community College Act]

In order to offset some of the costs associated with the development and maintenance of Morton College's new Digital Arts courses, Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning program, and the Physical Therapy Assistant program, an addition of a course fee or increase of a course fee will be applied to all Digital Art courses as well as identified courses in HVAC and PTA. Affixing these revised course fees will more responsibly align the student's portion of funding and reduce the College's subsidy. Even with these increases, Morton College will continue to be an outstanding educational bargain.

COST ANALYSIS:

\$ 50.00 addition/increase to fees in Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning

\$ 30.00 addition of fees in ART 130 and ART 131

\$ 40.00 addition/increase to fees in Physical Therapy Assistant (see attached spreadsheet for specific courses and amounts)

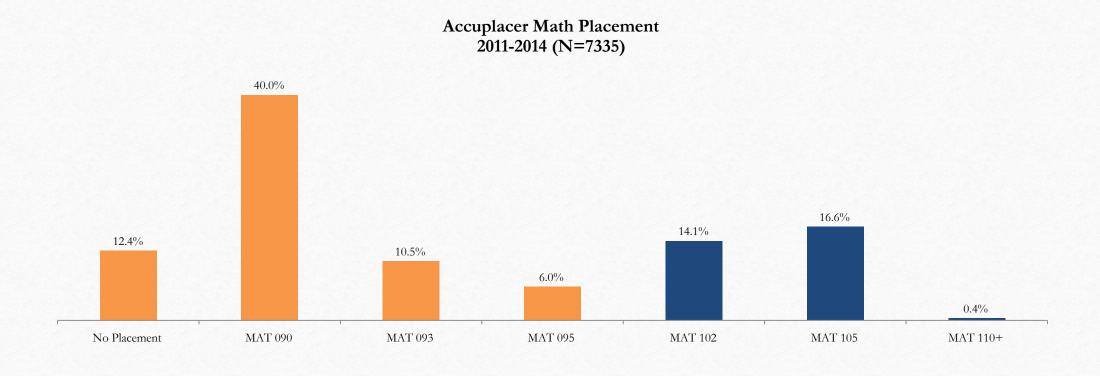

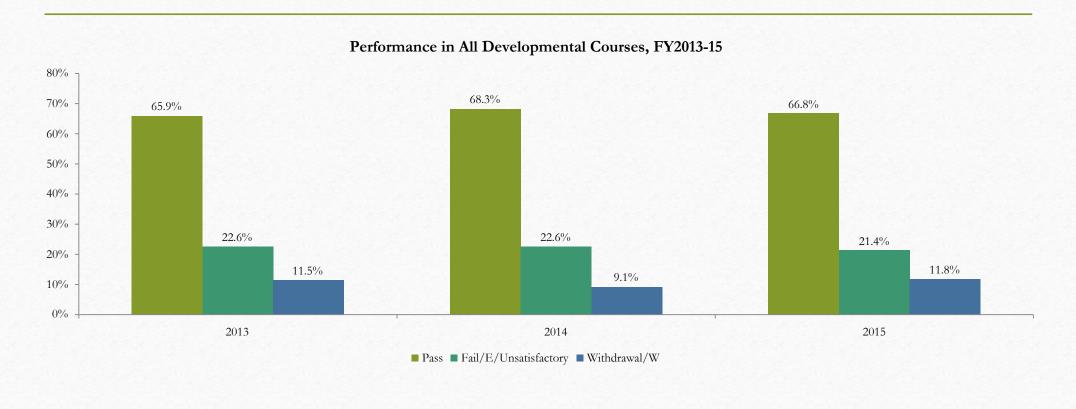




Accuplacer Math Placement
