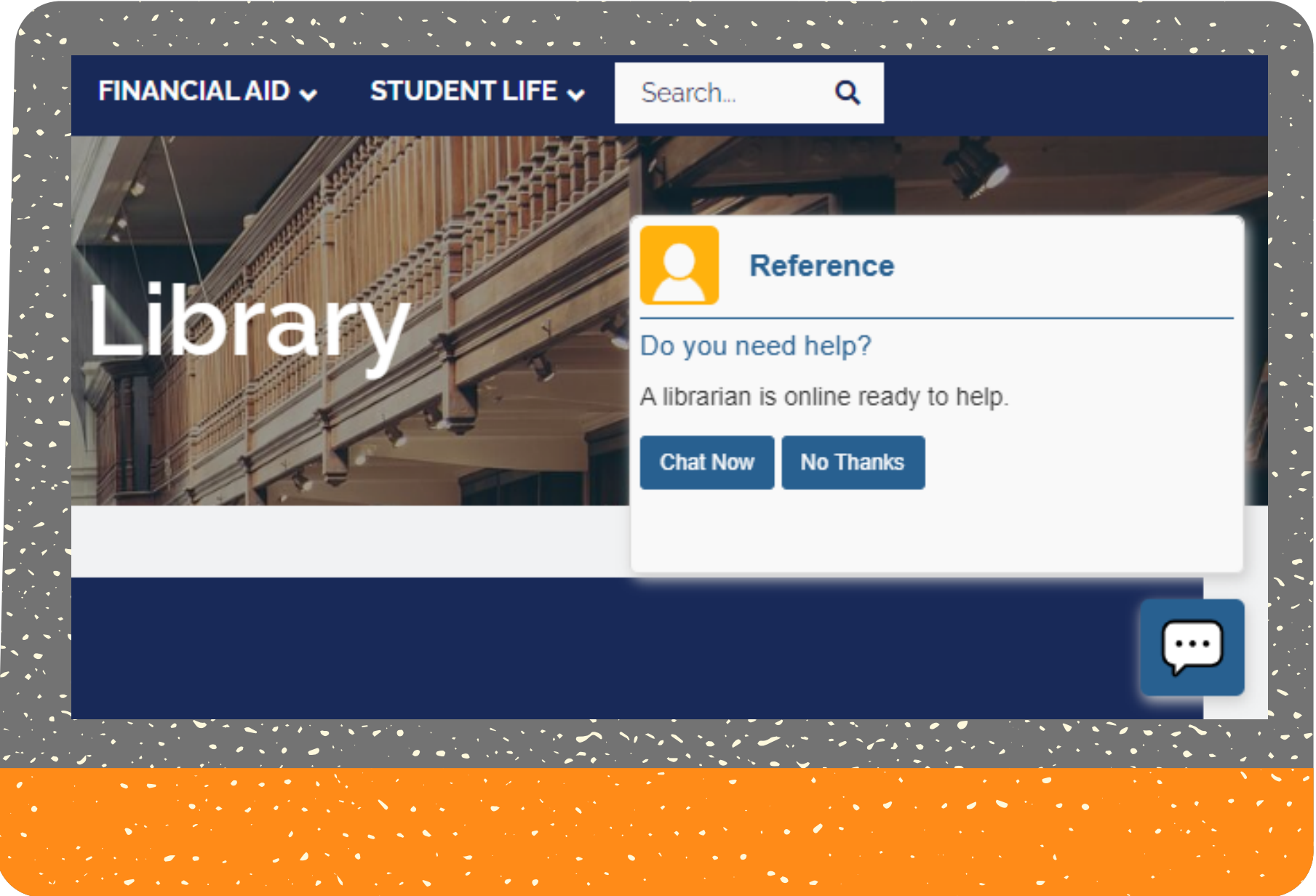
Career Services Office

OUR RESOURCES

The library provides its patrons with access to over 80 electronic databases; a collection of over 37,000 books, DVDs, CDs, newspapers, magazines, and scholarly journals; more than 100 computers and laptops; printing, faxing, scanning, and copying services; and access to over 90 Illinois higher education online catalogs via I-Share.

THINGS TO KNOW

You must have a valid Morton College ID card in order to check out material at the library. If you do not have one, you can have one made for you at the Reference Desk. You can use your ID card or a separate print card to print documents from the computer terminals. Loan periods are 4 weeks for books with the option to renew material up to 3 times. You may check out up to 10 items at any one time. You may also check out material from other colleges using I-Share.


Resources

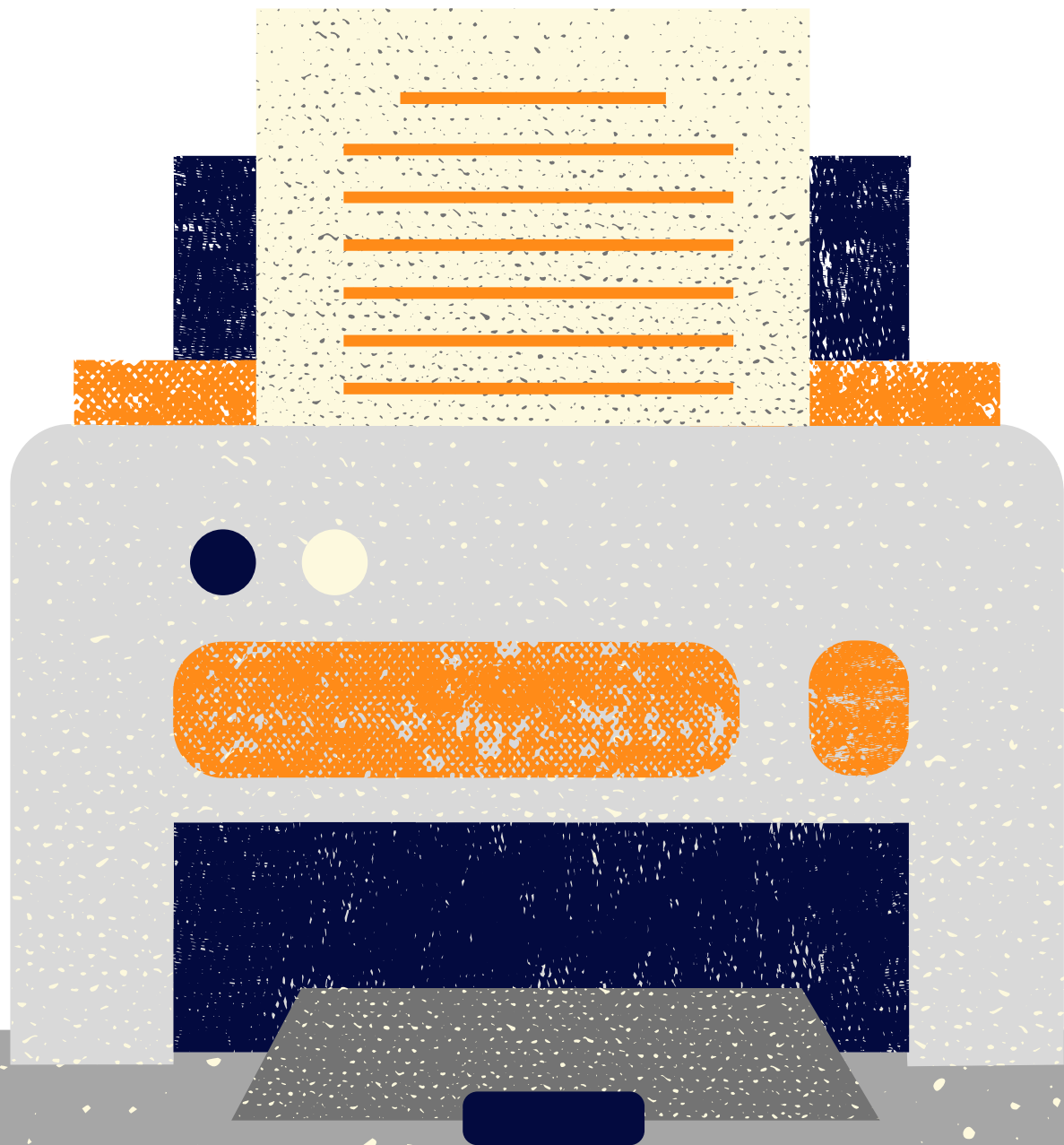
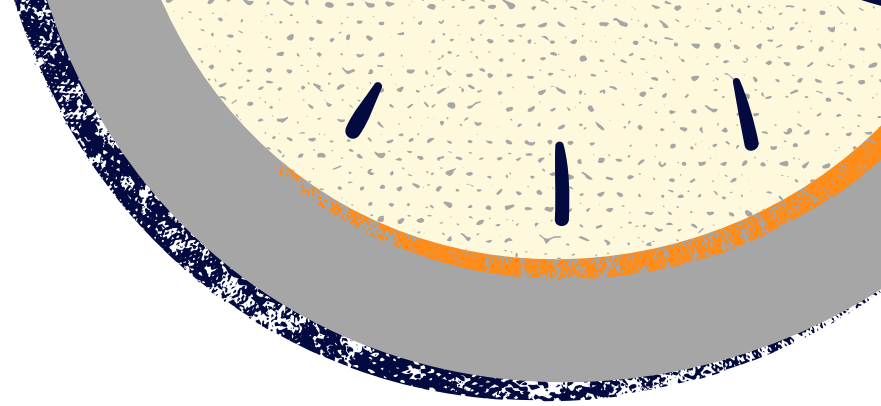
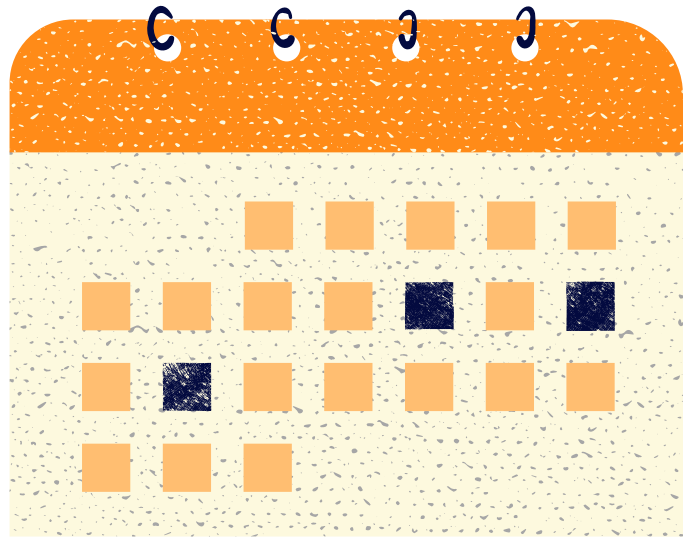


Wellness
