

Spring 2021 Tuition Due Schedule

If you register

Payment is due

Nov 2 – Nov 30**Nov 30, 2020**

On or after Dec 1**Full payment is due the same day**
of registration, **OR** sign up for
Nelnet Payment Plan

Please note The College may **drop** a student from their classes for not paying tuition.

If you do not want to remain enrolled in classes, please withdraw from them at the Office of Admissions & Records, 1st floor B Building, within the refund deadlines listed below. *Unless you withdraw from your classes within the refund deadlines, you will still have to pay your tuition*

Spring 2021 Tuition Refund Schedule

100% Refund – within 8 calendar days from start of course

50% Refund – 9 to 16 calendar days from start of course

Refunds will not be issued after these dates

You have until the close of business on the date above to receive a refund.

Any student with extenuating circumstances wishing to receive a 100% refund/withdrawal after the above published dates may submit a letter of explanation, signed drop form and any necessary documents to the Dean of Student Development. Refunds and withdrawals after the above dates are granted only under extraordinary circumstances. Please note that if any of the dates above should fall on a holiday, the next day is the deadline.

Sign up for Payment **Plan 1 by Nov 23:**

1. \$0 down
2. 5 monthly payments

Sign up for Payment **Plan 2 by Dec 16:**

1. 10% down
2. 4 monthly payments

Sign up for Payment **Plan 3 by Jan 11:**

1. 30% down
2. 3 monthly payments

Sign up for Payment **Plan 4 by Jan 25:**

1. 50% down
2. 2 monthly payments

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE NOTE

Students must pay their full balance either at the Cashier, 1st floor A Building, or online through your student portal. Students can also sign up for a Nelnet Payment Plan.

Nelnet Payment Plan options will not be available after January 25 for Spring 2021.

There is a \$25, non refundable fee to sign up for a Nelnet Payment Plan, and a \$30 returned payment fee if a payment is returned. A credit card, savings or checking account is necessary to participate in Nelnet.

If you are dropped from your courses, you may re-register, with no guarantee of obtaining the same course schedule.
