(Deadline May 24, 2021)
- Turned in all other official transcripts from other colleges**  
(Deadline May 24, 2021)
- Submit in-district employment verification form**  
(Deadline March 5, 2021)  
**NOTE:** Final in-district status for applicants submitting an In-District Employment Verification form is contingent upon review from the Registrar and verification by the Nursing committee
- Attend a Mandatory Nursing Information Session**  
(Deadline March 3, 2021)
- Pass Kaplan admission exam**  
(Deadline May 24, 2021)  
**NOTE:** Minimum composite score of 50% per section.
- Received grades of "C" or better in all minimum prerequisite courses by the end of the spring 2021 semester
