What can I do?



OFFER SUPPORT be a good listener and ask how you can help



SPEAK OUT encourage your friend to seek help



BE AN ADVOCATE educate yourself about sexual violence and healthy relationships



REPORT any sexual violence you witness

If you have experienced sexual violence:

- **GET TO A SAFE PLACE** as soon as possible.
- **CALL 911** or MC Campus Police 708.656.8000 Ext. 2200 or 2201
- PRESERVE ALL EVIDENCE (do not bathe, wash your hands, or clean anything). If you must change clothing, put all clothing you were wearing at the time of the incident in a paper (not a plastic) bag.
- **SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION**, immediately and preferably at an emergency room.
