Funds from the CRRSAA are intended to assist students with expenses for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare. All awards must adhere to federal statutory and regulatory requirements.

Students with incomplete 2020-21 FAFSA requirements are eligible to receive a \$300 CRRSAA Grant beginning April 12, 2021 to April 23, 2021. Students must prove eligibility by completing the 2020/21 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov and completing the process at MC.

The following must be met to be considered for an emergency grant:

- ALL Financial Aid requirements
- Must be eligible to receive a spring 2021 disbursement.
- Must be enrolled in the spring 2021 and actively pursuing your courses.

Early submission is recommended for full consideration. Please note: Students are only allowed to receive ONE payment under the COVID-19 Emergency Grant per term. Request for additional funding from this fund will be denied.
