Student Right to Know Information on Graduation, Transfer-out, and Retention Rates



The following information is provided in compliance with federal regulations. The rates below reflect the graduation and transfer-out status of students who enrolled in fall 2017 and were tracked for three years.

During the fall semester of 2017, 338 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2020):

- 21% had graduated from Morton College
- 17% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 19% were still enrolled at Morton College

During the fall semester of 2016, 338 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2019):

- 21% had graduated from Morton College
- 17% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 19% were still enrolled at Morton College

The retention rate is the percent of first-time, degree-seeking fall term students who re-enroll the following fall term.

- 72% of Fall 2018 full-time cohort students enrolled in Fall 2019
For Illinois Community Colleges, the full-time retention rate was 65%
- 50% of Fall 2018 part-time cohort students enrolled in Fall 2019
For Illinois Community Colleges, the part-time retention rate was 44%

In the 2019-20 academic year, 547 students graduated.

- 466 Associates degrees were awarded in 2019-20
- 134 Certificates were awarded in 2019-20

- 84% of graduates identified as Hispanic
- 5% of graduates identified as White
- 3% of graduates identified as Asian
- 3% of graduates identified as Black
- 4% of graduates did not identify a race or ethnicity
