What is a Reduction of Income (ROI)?

A family's 2019 total income is used to determine eligibility for a student's financial need on the 2021-2022 FAFSA. However, there may be circumstances that could drastically change a family's financial situation. In such cases, we may use your family's 2020 income or expected 2021 income to determine your Pell Grant Eligibility calculation.

INCOME MUST HAVE DECREASED BY 10% FOR THIS APPEAL TO BE CONSIDERED FOR REVIEW. Your 2021-2022 FAFSA must be on file and completed before your ROI can be reviewed. **Please Note: ROI will only be processed if reduction changes your eligibility for Title IV.**

IMPORTANT: A reduction in income request will not be considered for the following situations: (1) high consumer debt, (2) home mortgage expenses, and (3) car payments/expenses. <u>Also, you must be unemployed for at least 6 months</u> <u>before we will consider a request for reduction of income due to loss of employment.</u>
