The above-named student has been selected as a recipient of the 2021-2022 Academic Excellence Scholarship at Morton College.

The Academic Excellence will cover 100% of the student tuition and institutional fees (comprehensive fee, technology fee, and repair/renovation fee, registration fee) up to 30 credit hours for the year fall (15) and spring (15). **Please Note: Students are responsible for all other fees such as: lab, course, private, and material fees)**

To participate in the Academic Excellence Scholarship, the student agrees to the terms and conditions below:

Enrollment: Full-time enrollment for the fall and spring semesters shall consist of a minimum of 12 credit hours. **Failure to enroll full-time will result in the termination of the scholarship.**

FAFSA Completion: Students receiving the academic excellence scholarship may also apply for FAFSA.

Books/Supplies: The Academic Excellence Scholarship does not cover books. It is the students responsibility to check with the Financial aid office to see if they are eligible for a FAFSA book voucher to help pay book expenses.

Academic Standing: Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 each semester and maintain a 67 percent completion rate, based on the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards (SAP). Failure to maintain completion percentage requirement(s) portions of SAP standards, will place the Academic Excellence recipient on **WARNING** for the following semester. Failure to meet the Financial Aid SAP requirements for the second semester following the warning status will result in **TERMINATION** of the Academic Excellence Scholarship. All recipients must maintain all Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards. Failure to meet academic requirements will place the student in automatic **TERMINATION**.

Scholarship Duration: The Academic Excellence Scholarship is awarded for one year and renewable for one additional year should the student meet all requirements. This scholarship runs consecutively. At any time, the student leaves the school, is dismissed, stops attending or does not meet the above terms and conditions, the Academic Excellence Scholarship will be withdrawn and neither extended.

Community Service: Academic Excellence recipients are required to complete 15 community service hours per semester in order to maintain the scholarship. Please see community service opportunities such as the Greater Chicago Food Depository for volunteering opportunities. The student is responsible for reporting all financial assistance received or expected to receive to the Financial Aid Office.
