

2022-23 Verification Worksheet

Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called "verification." To verify you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Office will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent (if you are a dependent student) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so your financial aid will not be delayed.
