Student Right to Know Information on Graduation, Transfer-out, and Retention Rates



The following information is provided in compliance with federal regulations. The rates below reflect the graduation and transfer-out status of students who enrolled in fall 2018 and were tracked for three years.

During the fall semester of 2018, 256 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2021):

- 21% had graduated from Morton College
- 17% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 16% were still enrolled at Morton College

During the fall semester of 2017, 338 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2020):

- 21% had graduated from Morton College
- 17% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 19% were still enrolled at Morton College

The retention rate is the percent of first-time, degree-seeking fall term students who re-enroll the following fall term.

- 67% of Fall 2021 full-time cohort students enrolled in Fall 2022
- 50% of Fall 2021 part-time cohort students enrolled in Fall 2022

In the 2021-22 academic year, 590 students graduated.

- 507 Associates degrees were awarded in 2021-22
- 115 Certificates were awarded in 2021-22
- 86% of graduates identified as Hispanic
- 6% of graduates identified as White
- 2% of graduates identified as Asian
- 4% of graduates identified as Black
- 2% of graduates did not identify a race or ethnicity

Scholarship Athletes



The following information is provided in compliance with federal regulations. The rates below reflect the graduation and transfer-out status of student Athletes who enrolled in fall 2018 and were tracked for three years.

During the fall semester of 2018, 37 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking scholarship athletes entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2021):

- 14% had graduated from Morton College
- 32% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 8% were still enrolled at Morton College

During the fall semester of 2017, 33 first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking scholarship athletes entered Morton College. After three years (as of August 31, 2020):

- 27% had graduated from Morton College
- 36% had transferred to another college without completing a degree
- 6% were still enrolled at Morton College

The retention rate is the percent of first-time, degree-seeking fall term students who re-enroll the following fall term.

- 54% of Fall 2021 full-time cohort scholarship athletes enrolled in Fall 2022
- For Morton College as a whole, the full-time retention rate was 67%
