Documents needed for 2023-2024

Alternative Application:

If applying for 2022-2023: 2020 Federal Taxes are needed.

- 2021 Federal Income Tax Returns, W-2's, and other records of money earned.
- Records of untaxed income (IF APPLICABLE)
- List of colleges the student would like to attend. Parents of dependent students will also need most of the same information listed above

Documents needed for 2023-2024

FAFSA:

If applying for 2022-2023: 2020 Federal Taxes are needed.

- Student's driver's license and social security number.
- Student's and/or parents 2021 Federal Tax Return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, W2 Forms) Parent's social security numbers and date of birth.
- Parent's marital status (Month/Year).
- Records of untaxed income (Welfare, Social Security benefits, TANF, or Veterans benefits)
