

International Student Admission Requirements

Thank you for your interest in Morton College. We look forward to having you as an International student on our campus. Morton College is a 2 year public community college which offers 2 year Associate Degrees to International students. The college is located in the city of Cicero, which is adjacent to Chicago, Illinois. Current Enrollment is approximately 5,000 students. Morton College is a commuter institution and thus there is no on-campus housing available.

Requirements for Admission:

- **International Student Admission Application.**
- **Foreign Credential Evaluation** School transcripts must be translated to English. It is recommended that the official evaluation agency is a NACES accredited member as listed here: <https://www.naces.org/members>. Other evaluations may be accepted with prior approval.
- **Financial Affidavit of Support.** The forms are attached in this packet.
- **Bank statements** from one or more accounts. The form is included in this packet. A total minimum of **\$22,704** US dollars must be shown and must not be any older than 30 days prior to the application date.
- **Copies of passport** and visa (if applicable). Only students with a valid and approved F1 visa can study at Morton College.
- ***If you are a **transfer student** from another American college or university, you must submit official college transcripts.

English proficiency:

- **IELTS** score: 6.0 required for Intensive English program placement.
- Or
- **IELTS score:** 7.0 required to enroll in Associate's program. Placement testing, offered by the college, will also be required.
- Or
- **TOEFL** score: TOEFL®iBT Minimum score 65 required

TOEF/IELTS exemptions:

- Students whose native language or who originate from a predominantly English speaking country.
- ACT score of 18 or above in English and Reading
- SAT score of 490 or above in Evidence based Reading and Writing
