Although the AAS in Nursing is a career program, some colleges and universities will accept credit from this program. Many schools offer unique 3 + 1 RN to BSN completion programs, enabling Morton Nursing Graduates to complete their BSN in an accelerated timeframe. The program builds upon previous knowledge and experience gained in Morton's associate degree program, and is designed for the working RN who wants a cost-effective, quality education. - **Completion of TEAS Exam**
 - Exam consists of English and Language Usage, Math, Reading, and Science
 - No online TEAS exam scores accepted, still counts as an attempt
 - Applicants are allowed two attempts per application cycle (must transfer scores if taken elsewhere)
 - Retake eligible if minimum score of 40% on each TEAS section
 - Applicants with passing scores on the first attempt are not eligible to retake it during that admission cycle
 - Score is valid for 2 consecutive admission cycles
 - Most recent score stands. Applicants with a previous passing score who elect to retake the exam in the subsequent application cycle will forfeit the previous test result.
- **Mandatory attendance at a Nursing Information Session during the current application cycle**
(September 25, 2025, through January 15, 2026). Prior admission cycle attendance DOES NOT rollover.
